Distinguished Service to Cullman City Schools Award Criteria

This award recognizes three individuals/businesses/organizations for their contributions towards significantly impacting the Cullman City Schools. Contributions could include volunteer services, personal contributions and/or sacrifices to improve the lives of others. Nominees do not have to be graduates or have attended Cullman City Schools.

Promising Alumni Criteria

The promising alumni program is established to encourage prominent students to continue to be active with the Cullman City Schools and the Cullman City Schools Foundation after they graduate and begin their careers. Nominees should be recognized for excelling in leadership, scholastics, character, service, and potential. Nominees in this category should have attended or graduated from Cullman City Schools after 2008.
